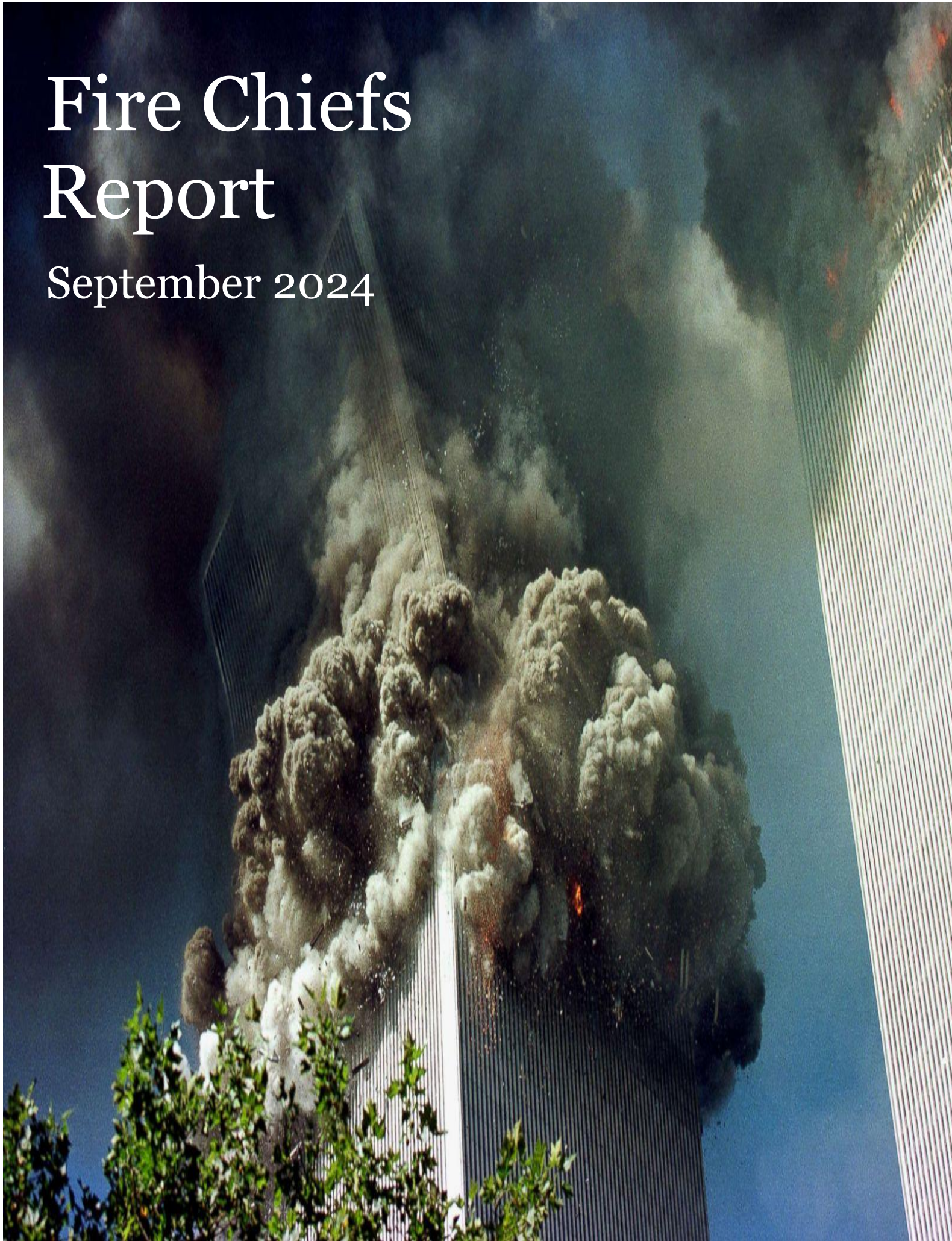


Fire Chiefs Report

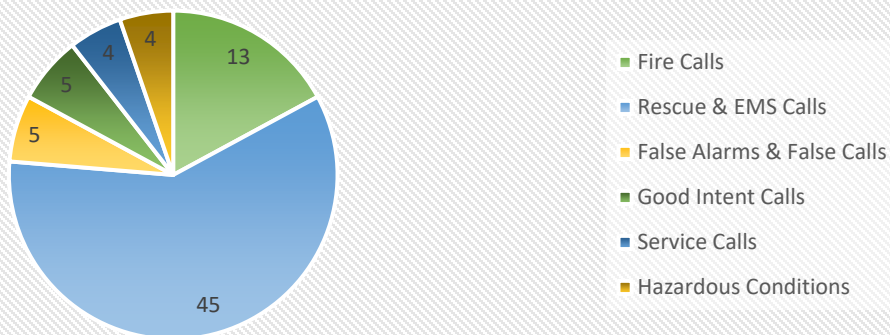
